	Internship Program	<p>Our SEU has an established, on-going Internship Program. Internships with our SEU are advertised over the air as well as on a number of college websites. Our SEU's EEO Coordinator and Promotions Assistant/Intern Coordinator are in contact with local colleges and universities and their internship representatives on a regular basis and work hard to develop these relationships for the benefit of the students as well as the Program.</p> <p>The student interns work in the SEU's Promotions, Programming, Sales, Marketing and Development and Sports Departments under the supervision of the SEU's Promotions Assistant/Intern Coordinator. Typical duties include conducting research for stories, assisting with script writing, collecting marketing data, participating in remote promotions/events and interviewing various managers within the SEU to learn more about their specific jobs. All interns earn college credits for completing a semester of work.</p> <p>During the Fall/Winter of 2011, our SEU hosted six (6) interns – one from the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay; one from the University of Wisconsin-Fox Valley; one from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee; and three from the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh.</p> <p>During the Winter/Spring of 2012, our SEU hosted four (4) interns – one from Lakeland College; one from the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh; one from the University of Wisconsin-Manitowoc; and one from the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay.</p> <p>During the Summer of 2012, our SEU is hosting eight (8) interns - one from the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh; one from Mankato State University; two from St. Norbert College; two from Northeast Wisconsin Technical College; and two from Bay Port High School.</p>
